Use these sentence planners to help children structure their spoken and written language. The colour coded questions provide reminders of the information they need to include in different types of sentences.

You can use the planners with pictures or words so the child can see the order the information needs to come in the sentence.




You can extend the use of this approach around the classroom to support understanding and use of correct sentence structures e.g. add the colour coded questions to interactive display boards.



e.g. Makena bought her new game in town




e.g. The big black dog is barking at the kitten
