



Hide And Seek

This game is to help your child follow instructions with several parts.

To play this game you will need two different small figures or soft toys e.g. play mobile or lego people.

First ask your child to close their eyes and then hide the two figures or toys around the room for your child to find. Try to hide them under and in things e.g. under a cushion, in a box.

Next give your child some instructions to find them. e.g. 'The power ranger is under a cushion.'

Encourage him or her to tell you where each figure or toy was once they have found them. You may have to encourage your child to use the right words. If your child makes a mistake repeat the correct word for them.

e.g child: 'Him behind there.'

adult: 'That's right, the power ranger was behind the cushion.'

Variations:

To make this game easier hide just one figure or toy.

To make this game harder use lots of figures to hide.
